Motion pictures are designed in terms of lighting and photography. (Apply the theory of cinematography).

Sound

The sound for motion pictures are designed and recorded. (Apply the theory of sound design).

Editing

Motion pictures are edited. (Apply the theory of editing).

Film theory & criticism :

The history of film and television are explained. Learners communicate in verbal, written and electronic formats. Motion pictures are marketed. (Apply the theory of film communication and marketing and review film and television productions).

Motion Picture Production :

A variety of motion pictures, such as dramas, documentaries, commercials, multi-camera studio productions, and so on are designed. (Produce film and television programmes).
